Additional Policies:

Advanced Placement (AP) credit from exams taken in 2021 will be awarded as it was in years past. Credit from AP exams will be awarded based on the scores earned for the subject area. To be eligible for credit, WCC must receive official AP test scores directly from the testing agency.

1. Student Records has discretion to give *elective credit* for AP work that has not been specified as a WCC course equivalent.
2. Exclusively, the Office of the Vice President for Instruction determines course equivalencies.
3. Students who earn a grade of three (3) or higher on an AP test shall be considered to have met college-level reading and college-level writing requirements without additional testing.
